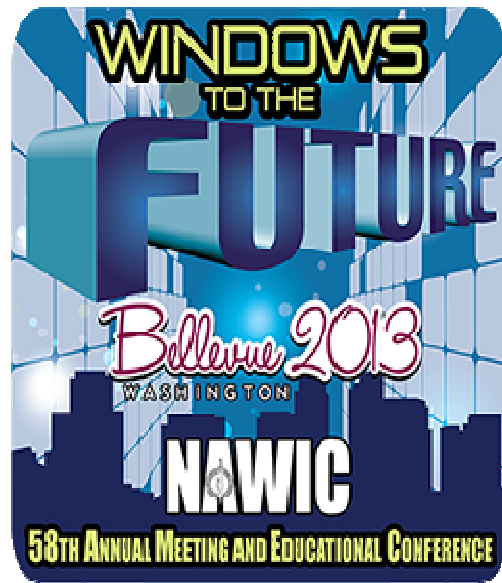

DID YOU KNOW!

NAWIC's fiscal year runs from October 1 – September 30. All members will receive a renewal notice prior to October 1 with instructions on how to renew their membership via email no matter when they joined throughout the year. NAWIC prorates your National Dues the second year of your membership. **All renewals are due by October 1**, renewals received after this date will obtain a \$25 late fee. Your National Dues will be prorated on a monthly basis at that time. **Student dues are not prorated.**

Prorate process:

New members pay the full amount when they join. However, at the member's first renewal their **NATIONAL DUES** will be prorated based on when they joined the previous year. Dues are prorated by dividing the full amount of national dues by 12 months and multiplying this by the number of months they were a NAWIC member in their first year. **Chapter dues are not prorated.** For example, a new member who joins in March will owe only seven months of national dues plus their full chapter dues at their renewal.
